Communicational availability

- ✓ Direct connections with almost all of the regions in country.
- ✓ Lubelskie region is the gateway to Eastern Europe and Asia - border area between the European Union and the Customs Union (Russia, Belarus, Kazakhstan).
- ✓ Well developed border crossing infrastructure with Ukraine and Belarus (7 crossing points).
- ✓ Pan-European transport corridor east-west/north-south - national road S-17 (Warsaw-Hrebenne-Lviv), S-12 (Warsaw-Lublin-Chełm-Dorohusk-Kiev), S-19 (Białystok-Rzeszów), the A2 motorway, railway line E20 (Paris - Moscow) and E7 (Gdynia - Odessa)
- ✓ Lublin-Świdnik airport one of the most modern airports in Poland - providing connections with numerous destinations in [Europe and Asia](#) [2].
- ✓ Dynamically developing network of expressways; delivery of 157 transport projects, valued at ca. PLN 1bn, under the Regional Operational Programme for Lubelskie Voivodeship for 2007-2031. The Regional Operational Programme (RPO) for 2014-2020 stipulates continued developments and upgrades of key transport routes, including provincial roads.
